

Porterville saaiprojek bereik nuwe mylpaal

Die saaiprojek van die Porterville-gemeenskapsvereniging het vanjaar 'n nuwe mylpaal bereik deur altesaam R200 000 aan begunstigdes te lewer. As 'n stigterslid van die vereniging, speel Kaap Agri tans 'n verneme rol om die volhoubaarheid van die projek te verseker.

Dié bedrag is onlangs by 'n geleentheid op die dorp aan die vereniging oorhandig om finansiële ondersteuning vir vier Porterville instansies te bied: Porterville Primêr, Hoërskool Porterville, Huis Nerina en Badisa Christelike welsynsorganisasie. Verlede jaar is R140 000 aan die begunstigdes oorhandig.

Die Porterville-gemeenskapsvereniging is in 2003 as 'n nie-winsgewende organisasie gestig. Alle winste wat uit hul bedrywighede gegenereer word, word aan die Porterville-gemeenskap oorgedra. Met hierdie doel is 'n saaiprojek in 2003 op die been gebring. Graan word op 25 ha meentgrond verbou. Die grond word gratis deur Bergrivier-munisipaliteit aan die vereniging beskikbaar gestel.

Verskeie verskaffers neem deel aan die projek deur van insette, soos saad, kunsmis, chemikalieë, asook dienste, soos kredietverskaffing, administrasie en kontrakwerk, ten volle of gedeeltelik te borg.

Gareth de Bruin, landbou-ekonoom by Kaap Agri, het

beklemtoon dat die betrokkenheid en ondersteuning van borge, die kern tot die sukses van die saaiprojek is.

"Dié ondersteuning het dit moontlik gemaak om gedurende die 2018/19-produksieseisoen 'n bedrag van R200 000 onder die begunstigdes te verdeel. Dit bring mee dat daar oor die afgelope 16 jaar altesaam R1 134 370 terug-geploeg is in die gemeenskap van Porterville," het hy gesê.

Die borge wat die projek reeds van sy ontstaan ondersteun, is die Bergrivier-munisipaliteit, Kaap Agri, Sensako, Yara, Soill, Omnia, Viking, Villa Crop Protection, AG-Sprayers en Louw & Cronje Geöktrooieerde Rekenmeesters, Wenkem, Inteligro, Nitrophoska, Bayer, RSAM, Mutual and Federal versekering, Syngenta, Porterville Korrektiewe Dienste en SA Kalk & Gips.

Wayne Dirks, voorsitter van die Porterville-gemeenskapsvereniging, het gesê die doelwit is dat die geld binne elke instansie aan minder bevoorregte persone beskikbaar gestel word. Gegewe die geselekteerde begunstigdes, kan daar afgelei word dat die klem hoofsaaklik op kinders en bejaardes geplaas word.

"Die Porterville-gemeenskapsvereniging streef daarna om op 'n volhoubare wyse, finansiële ondersteuning aan sy gemeenskap te bied en daadwerklik 'n verskil in die lewens van minderbevoorregtes te maak," het Dirks gesê.

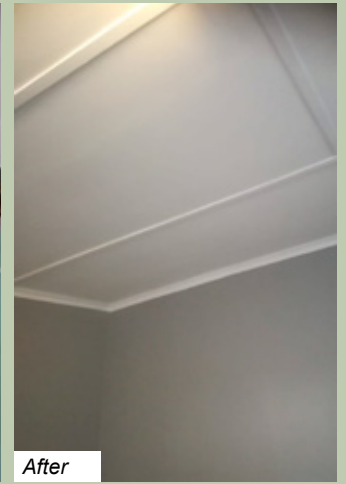
Agrimark Citrusdal gives residents a more dignified home

Heuwelrus in Citrusdal is an old age home that can accommodate 20 residents, but due to rooms that were in disrepair, they could only accommodate 16 people.

The residents struggle financially and are only living off their old age pension. Heuwelrus approached Agrimark Citrusdal. When branch manager, Chris Grobbelaar, saw the condition of the rooms, he contacted a contractor to provide him with a list of materials needed to do the repairs. The team completed the work to restore the run-down ceilings and bathrooms and demonstrated some amazing skills in the process.

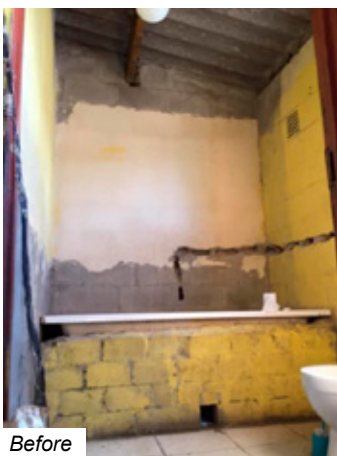

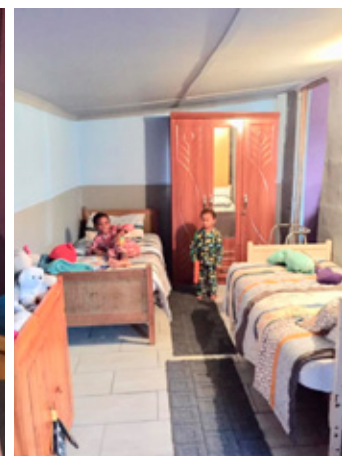
Agrimark Paarl helps with Ouma Meisie's home makeover

Agrimark Paarl answered the call of a local NPO (non-profit organisation) called HEART, which assists over 200 elderly and disabled beneficiaries living in vulnerable areas of Paarl.

The team at HEART needed to provide urgent assistance to Ouma Meisie, who is wheelchair-bound and the primary caregiver to her three grandchildren, aged 4 months, 3 years and 8 years respectively. The living conditions of the family were completely unsuitable and was earmarked as an emergency. The NPO approached potential sponsors in the hope of securing materials to

renovate the family's dwelling. Agrimark Paarl stepped in and sponsored all the materials needed for the home improvement, including the insulation, hardboard, stone and cement. Additional corporate sponsors and a registered contractor also assisted. The "big reveal" happened on Tuesday, 19 April 2019, a day before Ouma Meisie's birthday! Words cannot express the family's joy. The boys, especially, enjoyed the bathroom – complete with running water, a new toilet, wash-basin, new tiles and a working bath – and the first thing they did, was to have a bubble bath! 🌿
